CTR collaborates with Infilco Degremont to improve the waste water treatment plant at Heinz Frozen Food Company

This month CTR will complete fulfillment of an order for 37 semi-truck loads of ABF (Activated Bio-Filtration) Redwood fill media for Heinz Frozen Food Company. This plant produces over 600 million pounds of potato products annually and employs around 1,000 people. The Redwood ABF fill media will replace 17-year-old plastic fill media in a 30 foot tall by 80 wide tower.

Today CTR is the only remaining fabricator/supplier of ABF Redwood filtration media racks, as most plants are using synthetic fill media. High rate trickling Redwood media has the distinct characteristic of “Bio-roughing” which allows for higher organic and hydraulic loading. Simply stated the “bio-phage” has a stronger attachment to the redwood than plastic media. This treatment is preferable in the food processing environment.
